ORDER to COMPLY with SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY REQUIREMENTS

You have been convicted of the offense of insert offense which is a violation of 13 V.S.A. § insert statutory cite for offense. This is a Registry Offense and, pursuant to 13 V.S.A. §5402, you are hereby ORDERED to report to Vermont's Sex Offender Registry as follows:

- 1. You shall provide the court with the following information by Click here to enter a date: a. Your name b. Your date of birth

 - c. Your social security number

 - d. Your current address
 - e. Your current employment including the name and address of your employer
 - f. The name and address of any post-secondary educational institution at which you are enrolled.
 - g. Fingerprints, a photograph and a physical description obtained from the following agency:

A form that you can use to provide this information is attached.

- 2. Failure to provide this information as ordered will result in an order that you appear in court and show cause why you should not be held in contempt.
- 3. With the exception of any periods of time during which you are incarcerated, you are required to report to the Sex Offender Registry as follows:
 - a. Upon conviction of a registry offense in another state within 10 days after establishing residency in Vermont or crossing into this state for the purposes of employment or as a student.
 - b. Annually within 10 days of your birthday, unless the court has determined at sentencing that you are a "sexually violent predator" in which case you will need to report every 90 days.
 - c. Within three (3) days of any change of address, unless the Department of Corrections determines that you are a "high risk sex offender" in which case you must report a change of address within 36 hours and whether a child under the age of 18 resides at your new address.
 - d. Within three (3) days of any change of employment.
 - e. Within three (3) days of any name change.

- f. Within three (3) days of any child under the age of 18 moving into your residence.
- 4. Duration of reporting requirement: You shall continue to report to the Sex Offender registry as required under this Order for a period of 10 years from the date that you are released from prison, discharged for parole, supervised release or probation, whichever later occurs. However, if you are determined to be a "high-risk sexual offender" or a "sexually violent predator", or if you have more than one conviction for a Registry Offense¹, you are required to report to the Sex Offender registry for life except during periods of incarceration.
