Proposed Departments/Appropriations:

 - o Tobacco Litigation-funded programs

- Total appropriations: 13 (across 11 departments)
- Note: for "Year One" implementation purposes, we have selected appropriations that are essentially one-to-one relationship to respective programs.

Proposed Performance Measures:

- Departments will provide a maximum of **THREE** performance measures for each program/appropriation
 - o Note: Mark Friedman and other experts emphasize that reporting too many measures significantly dilutes the effectiveness of the process
- Measures derived from federal grant/programmatic requirements, where applicable, will be utilized
- Measures from Governor's Strategic Plan will be utilized where federal reporting measures are unavailable
- Selection of appropriate measures will be an ongoing dialogue between Administration and Legislature

Administrative/Overhead Costs:

- Some departments include personnel and administrative costs within these appropriations; others do not.
- Not feasible or advisable to restructure administrative cost centers before we know where the entire "program budget" initiative is headed.
- Proposal: Vantage will report a "Program Budget Form" that reports **BOTH/ALL**:
 - o Appropriation budget (from Vantage)
 - o Administrative/overhead expenses budgeted elsewhere self-reported by departments
