Reports due to HCOC during 2014

One-time reports:

- Enhanced Child Care Services Subsidy Program DCF to submit a written report to HCOC by November 2014 regarding the estimated cost of the Enhanced Child Care Services Subsidy Program, estimated cost of the increased Reach Up earned income disregard, and projected caseload reduction savings in the Reach Up program.
- **Reach Up earned income disregard** DCF to explore extent to which additional federal funding in SNAP could offset cost of food assistance during first five months of Reach Ahead, freeing up State funds to offset increase to Reach Ahead earned income disregard. DCF to submit report to HCOC by October 15, 2014, and HCOC to make recommendations its annual report based on the DCF report.

Ongoing reports:

- Adult protective services DAIL to provide quarterly reports for two years regarding DAIL's APS activities, including the number of reports of abuse, neglect, and exploitation that DAIL received and assigned for investigation and the reasons that some cases were not investigated. Reports were due January 15 and April 15 and next one is due July 15.
- **Blueprint annual report** due to HHC, SH&W, and HCOC by January 31 annually.
- Utilization of services and expenses in Choices for Care program -DAIL to report to General Assembly and HCOC quarterly
- **Pharmacy best practices and cost control program** DVHA to report quarterly to the HCOC regarding efforts to educate health care providers about the pharmacy best practices and cost control program as well as the numbers of prior authorizations and of utilization reviews
