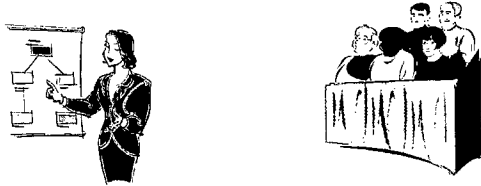
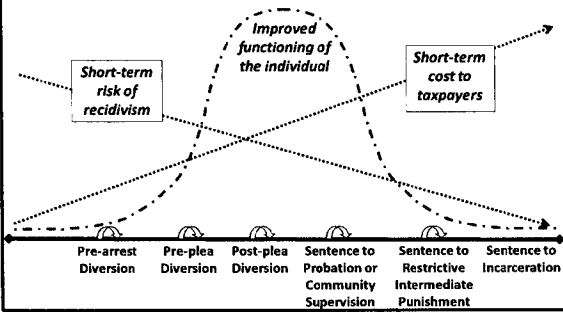

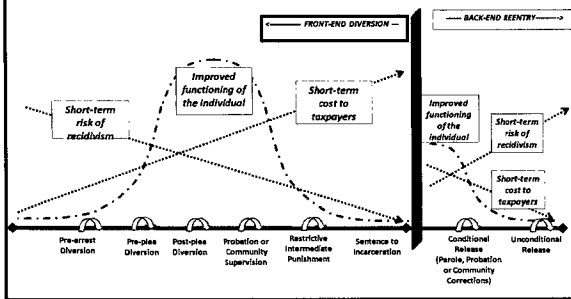

Dispositional Continuum

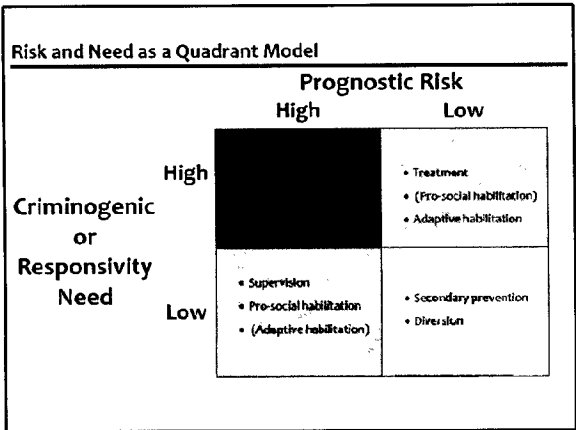


1. Prognostic Risk

- **Not necessarily a risk for violence or dangerousness**
- **Risk essentially means a difficult prognosis or lesser amenability to treatment**
- **The higher the risk level, the more intensive the supervision and accountability should be; and vice versa**
- **Mixing risk levels is contraindicated**

2. Criminogenic Need

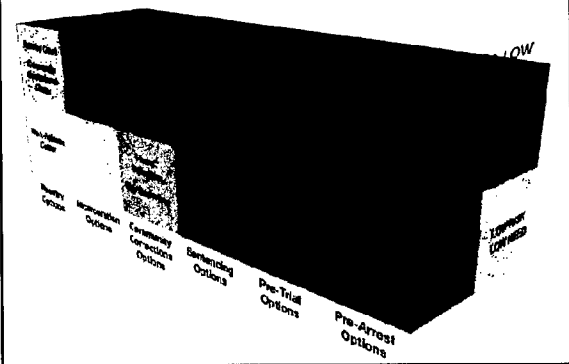
- **Clinical syndromes or functional impairments (diagnosis)**
- **Target criminogenic needs first**
- **The higher the need level, the more intensive the treatment or rehabilitation services should be; and vice versa**
- **Mixing need levels is contraindicated**



3. Point in System

- Limits available options (e.g., defense or prosecution buy-in)
- Limits available time period for treatment and supervision
- Limits available resources
- Differences in base rates for risk and need
- Influences risk or need level (e.g., reentry)
