

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on General, Housing and Military Affairs to which was
3 referred House Bill No. 275 entitled “An act relating to professional licensing
4 of members of the Armed Forces” respectfully reports that it has considered
5 the same and recommends that the bill be amended by striking out all after the
6 enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 Sec. 1. 21 V.S.A. § 1325 is amended to read:

8 § 1325. EMPLOYERS’ EXPERIENCE-RATING RECORDS;

9 DISCLOSURE TO SUCCESSOR ENTITY

10 (a)(1) The Commissioner shall maintain an experience-rating record for
11 each employer. Benefits paid shall be charged against the experience-rating
12 record of each subject employer who provided base-period wages to the
13 eligible individual. Each subject employer’s experience-rating charge shall
14 bear the same ratio to total benefits paid as the total base-period wages paid by
15 that employer bear to the total base-period wages paid to the individual by all
16 base-period employers. The experience-rating record of an individual subject
17 base-period employer shall not be charged for benefits paid to an individual
18 under any of the following conditions:

19 * * *

1 deployment orders, and when such relocation would make it impractical or
2 impossible, as determined by the Commissioner, for the individual to continue
3 working for such employment unit.

4 * * *

5 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

6 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.

7 and that after passage the title of the bill be amended to read: “An act relating
8 to unemployment insurance benefits for military spouses”.
