2	The Committee on Government Operations to which was referred House Bill
3	No. 602 entitled "An act relating to municipal budget committees" respectfully
4	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the bill be
5	amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
6	thereof the following:
7	Sec. 1. 17 V.S.A. § 2646 is amended to read:
8	§ 2646. TOWN OFFICERS; QUALIFICATION; ELECTION
9	At the annual meeting, a town shall choose from among its legally qualified
10	voters the following town officers, who shall serve until the next annual
11	meeting and until successors are chosen, unless otherwise provided by law:
12	* * *
13	(8) A collector of current taxes, if the town so orders votes;
14	(9) A collector of delinquent taxes, if the town so orders votes, for a
15	term of one year unless a town votes that a collector of delinquent taxes shall
16	be elected for a term of three years. When a town votes for a three-year term
17	for the collector of delinquent taxes, that three-year term shall remain in effect
18	until the town rescinds it by the majority vote of the legal voters present and
19	voting at an annual meeting, duly warned for that purpose;
20	* * *
21	(12) A trustee of public funds if the town has so ordered votes;

1	* * *
2	(14) A cemetery commissioner if the town has so ordered votes;
3	(15) One or more patrol officers to patrol town highways under the
4	direction of the selectboard, if the town so orders votes;
5	(16) One or two road commissioners who shall be elected by ballot if
6	the town has so ordered votes; otherwise they shall be appointed by the
7	selectboard as provided in section 2651 of this chapter. The road
8	commissioners shall be elected for a term of one year unless a town votes that
9	the commissioners shall be elected for a term of two or three years. When a
10	town votes for a two-year or three-year term for the office of road
11	commissioner, that two-year or three-year term shall remain in effect until the
12	town rescinds it by the majority vote of the legal voters present and voting at
13	an annual meeting, duly warned for that purpose;
14	(17) Three water commissioners unless the town votes to elect
15	additional selectboard members, in which case the number of water
16	commissioners shall, at the discretion of the selectboard, be the same as the
17	number of members that comprise the selectboard. The commissioners shall
18	be elected by ballot if the town has so ordered votes; otherwise they shall be
19	appointed by the selectboard as provided in section 2651 of this chapter:
20	(18) Five members of an advisory budget committee, if the town so

votes, unless the town votes to elect additional advisory budget committee

1	members. The advisory budget committee members shall be elected by ballot
2	unless the town votes to have those members appointed by the selectboard.

5	§ 1147. ADVISORY BUDGET COMMITTEE CREATION; DUTIES
6	If a municipality creates an advisory budget committee as provided in
7	17 V.S.A. § 2646, the committee shall evaluate the municipality's budget and
8	make recommendations to the selectboard for the budget based on its findings.
9	Sec. 3. EFFECT OF ACT; PREVIOUS TOWN ORDERS
10	A town that has ordered the election of officers under the provisions of
11	17 V.S.A. § 2646 prior to the effective date of Sec. 1 of this act may continue
12	to elect those officers after the effective date of Sec. 1 of this act.
13	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
14	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
