8	(d) The Judicial Nominating Board shall adopt rules under 3 V.S.A. chapter	
9	25 which that shall establish criteria and standards for the nomination of	
10	qualified candidates for justices <u>Justices</u> of the supreme <u>Supreme</u> Court,	
11	superior Superior Court judges, magistrates Magistrates, the Chair of the	
12	Public Service Board, and members of the Public Service Board. The criteria	
13	and standards shall include such factors as integrity, legal knowledge and	
14	ability, judicial temperament, impartiality, health, experience, diligence,	
15	administrative and communicative skills, social consciousness, and public	
16	service. The application form shall not be included in the rules and may be	
17	developed and periodically revised at the discretion of the Board.	
18	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE	
19	This act shall take effect on passage.
