

# **Amendments to S 86**

**For the purpose of ending censorship of balloted candidates.**

## **PARTICIPATION**

- 1. Candidates that are legally on the ballot must be permitted to participate**
- 2. in any publicly advertised or transmitted debate or forum of their race.**
- 3. A candidate may not be censored by private debate hosts or threatened**
- 4. with arrest to prevent participation in public debates or forums.**
- 5. The host of the debate or forum must allow each candidates equal**
- 6. opportunity to respond to questions and may not favor one or another of**
- 7. the candidates.**

## **DECORUM**

- 8. All candidates must conduct themselves with complete decorum.**
- 9. No candidate may use costumes, props, signs, loud or offensive language**
- 10. during the course of the forum or debate.**
- 11. A candidate that fails to observe proper conduct may receive**
- 12. one warning, and may be subsequently barred from further participation**
- 13. in subsequent debates by failing to observe appropriate decorum.**

## **POLLS**

**14. Polls conducted for the purpose of elections must name by name all**

**15. balloted candidates in any and all polls regarding that race for the**

**16. duration of the full election season.**
