13	refill an electronic delivery device. The requirement in Subdivision 1 of this section shall not
14	apply to a A "nicotine liquid container" shall not include that containsof a nicotine liquid or other
15	substance containing nicotine that is sold in a prefilled, sealed cartridge that is sold, marketed, or
16	intended for use in an electronic delivery device, provided that such cartridge is prefilled and
17	sealed by the manufacturer, and not intended to be opened by the consumer.
18	Subd. 3. Penalties. Any person that engages in retail sales of liquid nicotine containers
19	in violation of this section is subject to administrative penalties under section 461.12, subdivision
20	<u>2.</u>
21	Subd. 4. Preemption. Upon the effective date of the final regulations issued pursuant to
22	21 U.S.C. § 387a(b) that expand the United States Food and Drug Administration's authority to
23	include the regulation of electronic delivery devices, the provisions of this section shall be null,
24	void and of no force and effect, provided that such final regulations include provisions
25	mandating child-resistant effectiveness standards for liquid nicotine containers."
