2	The Committee on Human Services to which was referred House Bill No.		
3	555 entitled "An act relating to the commitment of a criminal defendant who is		
4	incompetent to stand trial because of a traumatic brain injury" respectfully		
5	reports that it has considered the same and recommends that the report of the		
6	Committee on Judiciary be amended as follows:		
7	First: In Sec. 13, in subsection (a), after the word "Judiciary" by inserting ,		
8	the House Committee on Human Services, and the Senate Committee on		
9	Health and Welfare		
10	Second: In Sec. 13, by striking out subsection (c) in its entirety and		
11	inserting in lieu thereof a new subsection (c) to read as follows:		
12	(c) On or before October 1, 2014 and on or before February 1, 2015, the		
13	Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living shall report to the		
14	House and Senate Committees on Judiciary, the House Committee on Human		
15	Services, and the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare on the status of the		
16	Department's progress toward implementation of this act. The status reports		
17	shall include updates on the Department's progress in evaluating best practices		
18	for treatment of persons with traumatic brain injuries who are unable to		
19	conform their behavior to the requirements of the law, and in identifying		
20	appropriate programs and services to treat those persons consistent with the		
21	need for public safety. The status reports shall also include updates on the		

1	Department's progress developing the programs and services needed to treat		
2	persons with traumatic brain injuries who h	nave been found not guilty by reason	
3	of insanity or incompetent to stand trial as required by this act.
