- 1. Proposes a shift in focus within the Workforce Education and Training System to be more job-driven as the primary outcome. [*H.* 852 pg. 2 pg. 12, line 14]
- 2. Realign the governance structure of the Workforce Development Council to support the state's Workforce Dev. Strategic Plan and clarify the role of the Commissioner of Labor as the Coordinator of Workforce Development and Training and steward of the state plan. [*H.* 852 pg. 12; line 15- pg. 24 and pg. 31-341
- 3. Will propose, through the committee process, new strategies for evaluation of programs which have historically been difficult to evaluate for effectiveness and scalability. [*H.* 852 pg. 25 pg. 30]
- 4. Prepare the state to be more competitive for federal money, especially in light of the newly announced Biden-led federal initiative to do similar analysis of the federal system.
- 5. Clean up statutes and session law, eliminating redundancies and defunct program language.
