### PERMIT PROCESS

- \* Town of Killington
  - > Planned Unit Development
    - Village Master Plan
    - 400 Acre PUD (Amendment)
    - Site Plan (Last Step Outstanding)
- \* Agency of Natural Resources
  - > 14 Separate Permits/Approvals
- **Act** 250
  - ➤ Killington Village Master Plan
    - Overall Subdivision
    - Village Master Plan
    - Phase I of Village Master Plan

## **ACT 250**

- Permit Received
  - > Overall Subdivision
    - 11 Boundary Adjustments
    - 4 Stand-Alone Lots
  - > Phase I of the Village Master Plan
- \* Review/Approval of Village Master Plan
  - > Killington Village Master Plan
    - Very limited findings
    - Findings received that were not requested
- \* Various conditions create "No-Go" situation

# **ACT 250 APPEAL**

- ❖ Stephen Durkee − Stormwater/Aesthetics
  - Adjacent Property Owner
  - > Unclear party status on other properties
- \* RPCs Traffic/Affordable Housing
  - Rutland Regional Planning Commission
  - > TRORPC & SWCRPC
  - Four Month Delay (July to November)
- Other Issues
  - > All buildings sprinklered
  - Parking monitoring language (Town Zoning Issue)

## TID LEGISLATION

- \* Transportation Improvement District
  - > Fair Share Transportation Assessment
  - Not aware of a Bill Number yet

#### Issues

- > Create a law consistent with our Act 250 Traffic Issue
- Possibly an issue in Burlington area, but doesn't relate to well to rural situations
- District Commission involvement with input from RPCs
- Lack of detail in existing draft legislation
- ➤ Possibility of limiting future development/growth in the State of Vermont
