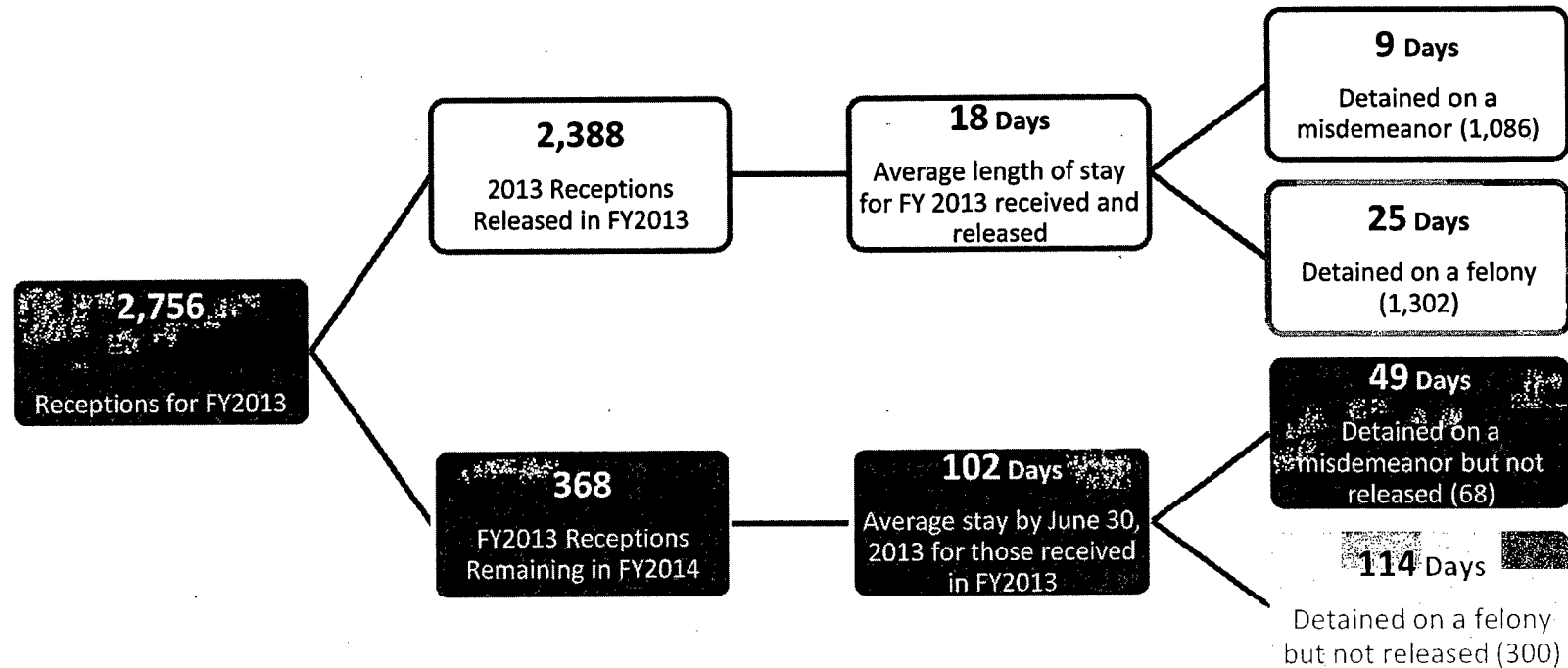


# Dataset of Total FY 2013 Detainee Receptions Shows Average Length of Stay at 18 Days for Those Released

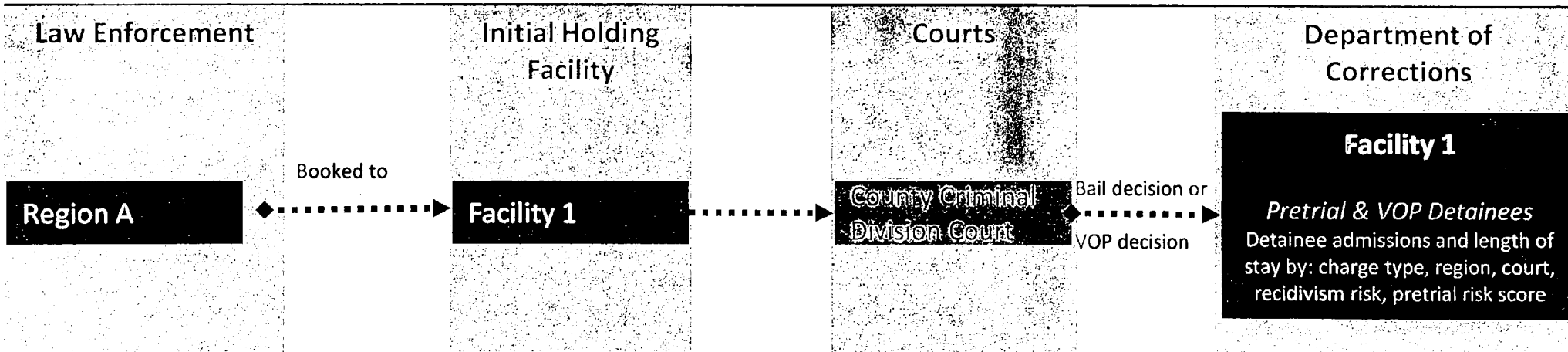

# Opportunities to Effect Admissions

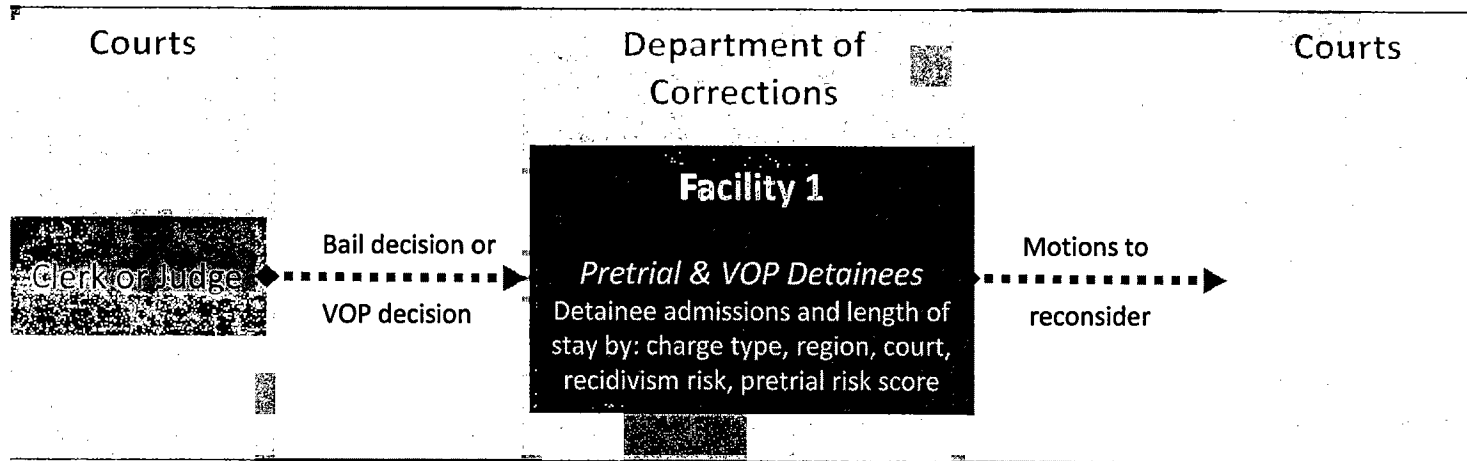


- Are there places where citations would do in lieu of arrests?
