2 Representatives Komline of Dorset and Wright of Burlington move that the
3 House propose to the Senate that the bill as amended by the Committees on
4 Fish, Wildlife and Water Resources and on Ways and Means be further
5 amended by striking out Sec. 4, effective date, in its entirety and inserting in
6 lieu thereof two new sections to be Secs. 4–5 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 4. 7 V.S.A. § 1012 is added to read:

8 § 1012. LIQUID NICOTINE; PACKAGING

9 (a) As used in this section, “liquid nicotine container” means a bottle or
10 other container that contains liquid nicotine or other substance containing
11 nicotine, where the liquid or other substance is sold, marketed, or intended for
12 use in an electronic delivery device.

13 (b) Unless specifically preempted by federal law, a liquid nicotine
14 container that is sold at retail in the State shall satisfy the child-resistant
15 effectiveness standards under 16 C.F.R. § 1700.15(b)(1) when tested in
16 accordance with the requirements of 16 C.F.R. § 1700.20.

17 Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATES

18 (a) Secs. 1–3 and this section shall take effect on passage.

19 (b) Sec. 4 (liquid nicotine; packaging) shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
