14	(b) Each contract awarded under this section for any State construction
15	project with a construction cost exceeding \$100,000.00 and projects which is
16	are authorized or funded in whole or in part by a capital construction act
17	pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 701a, including such a project of the University of
18	Vermont and State Agricultural College and of the Vermont State Colleges,
19	shall provide that all construction employees working on the project shall be
20	paid no less than the mean prevailing wage published periodically by the

1	Department of Labor in its occupational employment and wage survey
2	determinations as have been made by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of
3	Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, 40 U.S.C. § 276a, as may be
4	amended. The Commissioner of Labor, in consultation with the Commissioner
5	of Buildings and General Services, may adopt rules as necessary, pursuant to 3
6	V.S.A. chapter 25, to implement this subsection. This section does not require
7	that the federal Davis-Bacon Act reporting requirements be applied to State
8	construction projects.
