Subject: Review of Administration's Proposed FY 2015 Fee Bill

The House Ways and Means Committee has begun work on the Administration's proposed FY 2015 Fee Bill and would like the Committee on Government Operations to review Sections 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18 and 19.

Sections 11-13 relate to fees for the registration of individual lobbyists and lobbying firms, fees for filing late registrations, as well fees for the filing of late disclosures to be made by lobbysists, lobbying firms, or employers who engage with lobbyists. The fee increases are to more closely align fees in Vermont to those in other States and to create a new lobbyist disclosure database.

Sections 14 and 16-19 pertain to fees falling within the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State's Office of Professional Regulation. The fee increases are to keep revenues and expenditures in balance for each professional board. The following professional boards are seeking fee changes: Chiropractic, Funeral Directors, Professional Nursing, Nursing Assistants and Optometry.

It would be helpful if you could respond with any recommendations by the end of the day on January 22nd. Thank you in advance for your consideration.

- (f) Every employer and every lobbyist shall pay an initial registration fee of \$25.00 \$50.00.
