Director's Report Fiscal Year 2013

Director's Report

Fiscal year 2013 was a challenging one for the Office of Professional Regulation. Tropical Storm Irene and the displacement of hundreds of state employees in the destroyed Waterbury complex eventually led to OPR's departure from its offices in the National Life Building to make space for the Agency of Natural Resources. Most of OPR had been at National Life for five years and the investigation and prosecution units barely a year. Those moves had finally accomplished our long term goal of uniting OPR in one space, something that was working quite well and leading to many efficiencies and reduced case processing times. As one might imagine, we were reluctant to move again and adamant that we would find a space to accommodate all of OPR and maintain or improve upon the vital conference space needed to conduct board business.

Despite our best efforts, the office was forced to move twice: once in December 2012 to a temporary location at Vermont College and again in July 2013 to our current home in the City Center Building in downtown Montpelier. These moves went remarkably well and the adaptable and unshakeable OPR staff deserves a great deal of credit for virtually no drop-off in service despite these two moves. We also turned these challenges into opportunities for designing a new space to fit our needs and to manage our records. After two moves in six months and all of that packing and unpacking, I dare say we are the most organized agency in state government! We are now settling into our new space and are probably even better off in the long run.

OPR continues to move forward with technology enhancements that make us more efficient and handling more work while holding steady with our budget and staffing levels. In the face of the logistical space challenges described above, we still managed to implement a major upgrade to our elicense licensing and enforcement system, enabling additional features we have used to reduce costs an improve efficiencies by moving to paperless renewals and email notifications, saving on paper, postage, and staff time, while improving response times for applications, renewals and enforcement cases.

Notably, for the first time in more than a decade, the number of complaints received by OPR declined (739) after doubling in number between 2007 (411) and 2012 (822). This decline, combined with a fully staffed investigative unit and a highly productive enforcement team, should lead to a drop in the overall caseload in FY14 and even more efficient processing times. Our priority is always to improve upon application and case processing times to better serve the public without compromising public protection.

Last of all, Vermont is entering a new era of health care reform. The Office of Professional Regulation has a role to play in bringing about better health care for Vermonters. Primarily, OPR is in the best position to collect work force data from health care professionals at renewal time. Through online licensing, OPR can collect survey data about licensee practice locations, settings and specialties. This critical information can then be analyzed to determine which areas of the state are underserved and to identify current and future work force shortages. Armed with this information, state and federal agencies can plan for the future health care workforce and spend our tax dollars in ways that gets the most return for each dollar spent. I am participating on the Governor's Task Force on Work Force issues and am pleased to be able to serve with such dedicated people from across all professions and state government in helping to deliver care all Vermonters can be proud of.




