7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the
8 charge of the Vermont Child Poverty Council to authorize specifically the
9 Council to meet during the legislative session.

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

15 (b)(1) The ~~council~~ Council shall consist of the following members or their
16 designees:

18 (3) The ~~council~~ Council shall meet up to six times while the ~~general~~
19 ~~assembly~~ General Assembly is not in session to perform its functions under
20 this section. ~~In addition, during the 2007 legislative interim, the council shall~~

1 ~~hold 14 public hearings as required under subsection (d) of this section. The~~
2 Council may meet an unlimited number of times during the legislative session,
3 but Council members shall not receive compensation or compensation and
4 reimbursement for expenses pursuant to subsection (e) of this section for
5 participation in meetings during the legislative session.

7 (e) Funds from private and public sources may be accepted and utilized by
8 the ~~council~~ Council to develop and implement the plan and provisions of this
9 section. ~~Legislative~~ For participation in meetings during the legislative
10 interim, legislative members of the ~~committee~~ Council shall be entitled to
11 compensation and reimbursement for expenses under ~~section 406 of Title 2~~
12 2 V.S.A. § 406. All other members not receiving compensation for service on
13 the ~~committee~~ Council from another source are entitled to compensation under
14 ~~section 1010 of Title 32~~ 32 V.S.A. § 1010 for participation in meetings during
15 the legislative interim.
