Victim Compensation Special Fund

## Receipts:

$\$ 29.75$ of $\$ 46.00$ surcharge on criminal convictions and traffic tickets.

## Disbursements:

Victim Compensation Program Reimbursement of out-of-pocket (uninsured) crime-related losses for medical, dental, counseling, funeral, re-location, safety and security, and transportation. Requires a police report finding probable cause a crime was committed. Does not require a prosecution/conviction

Sexual Assault Program
Covers the cost of forensic rape exams, STD and HIV screening and prophylaxis treatment and 20 counseling sessions. Victim does not have to use their health insurance. Does not require police report, prosecution or conviction. Victims do not have to use insurance.

## Victim Assistance Program

22 FTE Victim Advocates who work out of the state's attorneys' offices. Work with crime victims whose cases are being prosecuted.
