Based on analysis of the non-emergency involuntary medication spreadsheet maintained by the Vermont Department of Mental Health, Legal Division. Non-emergency involuntary medication data represents filings with a petition date from January 2012 through November 2013. Mean and median time between significant events is based upon valid dates reported for significant dates. Median is the numerical value separating the higher half of a data collection from the lower half. Mean is the sum of a collection of numbers divided by the number of numbers in the collection (commonly known as the average). Negative values represent events where the order of events is reversed; for example, a negative time from commitment to hospital petition represents that the hospital petition occurred before the commitment. One involuntary medication proceeding record was omitted due to the uniqueness of the case.
