6	(a) Creation. The Prekindergarten-16 Council shall create a working group
7	from among its membership to review and evaluate issues of equity in and
8	access to Vermont's expanded learning programs, including afterschool and
9	summer programs. The Working Group shall obtain testimony from
10	existing providers of extended learning programs, including the
11	Governor's Institutes of Vermont and the Vermont Youth Conservation
12	Corps. In particular, the Working Group shall identify:
13	(1) ways to increase connections between schools and afterschool and
14	summer learning programs;
15	(2) ways to coordinate school-run programs and programs sponsored by
16	community-based and statewide organizations;
17	(3) areas of the State with limited or inequitable access to expanded
18	learning programs, models successfully serving populations in those areas,
19	and the barriers to operating programs in those areas;
20	(4) the key elements of afterschool and summer learning programs that
21	should be encouraged by State policy decisions in order to:

1	(A) ensure that programs are of the highest quality;
2	(B) contribute to more effective school-year approaches to educating
3	underserved learners in Vermont and provide program content that
4	reflects Vermont's educational and workforce development priorities;
5	(C) determine how a more comprehensive statewide strategy to
6	promote high-quality afterschool and summer learning programs could be
7	implemented over time;
8	(D) consider how changes to the school calendar may affect time
9	available for learning; and
10	(E) identify how best to coordinate and augment existing funding
11	streams for afterschool and summer learning programs and ensure that
12	programs are cost-effective, effective in reaching and producing
13	outcomes for targeted populations, and non-duplicative.
14	(b) Report. On or before December 31, 2014, the Working Group shall
15	report to the House and Senate Committees on Education with its findings and
16	any recommendations for legislative action.
