Potential Amendments (as of 4/17/14):

Secs. 8–9 (online postsecondary): add clarification of “nondegree-granting, noncredit-granting” to programs offered by trade associations, etc.

Sec. 10 (residency for student awaiting adoption): delete Sec. 10 because Sec. 11 sufficient

Sec. 19 (CTE regional advisory board): QUESTION: remove strike-through from “employees” in subsection (5)???

Sec. 23(b) (transportation to CTE): delete subsection (b) and replace with “* * *” so law is unchanged

Sec. 29 (UVM tuition): replace with new, more streamlined language

Sec. 30 (tiered system of supports): two amendments to subsection (a) –

- remove strike-through from “an educational support team and”
- delete new language “, and intensive, individualize interventions for any student requiring a higher level of support”

Sec. 34 (expanded learning opportunities; study):

- remove Sec. 34?
OR
- add in Governor’s Institute’s language ?

Sec. 36 (audits): delete Sec. 36 so annual audit requirement remains in place

Possible Additional Sections:

1. Dual Enrollment:
 - a. private-pay, nonsectarian approved independent schools
 - b. add in sectarian as well
2. Technology Innovation: requested membership changes from Reps Buxton and Campion
3. School Lunch Nonpayment by Parents: requested memo from AOE indicating what they could do to help – add Sec. directing them to do so?
