Local Education Agency (School District) Finance Survey (F-33) Data

The primary purpose of the Local Education Agency (School District) Finance Survey (F-33) is:

- to provide revenue and expenditure data for all school districts in the United States.

These data are also collected by the Governments Division of the U.S. Census Bureau, and have been released as the F-33 survey. The original file is Version 1a, the revised file is Version 1b, etc. A sample of school district data were collected in school years 1990-91, 1992-93 and 1993-94.

Revenues and expenditures are audited after the close of the fiscal year and are then submitted to NCES by each state education agency. Beginning with fiscal year 1990, detailed fiscal data on revenues and expenditures for all school districts providing public education to pre-kindergarten to grade 12 students have been collected. These data can be linked to the data collected on the nonfiscal CCD Local Education Agency Universe. Student counts and amounts of debt at the beginning and end of the fiscal year are also provided.
