Purpose: The changes are as follows:

1. To allow officers in charge the ability to issue NJP.
2. To grant to a general offer the ability to delegate some of his/her duties under this to a primary staff officer
3. To make clear that when a commander seeks to consider restrictions on liberty, then the member is entitled to demand a courts martial. When a commander does not want to consider any restrictions on liberty and the member is offered a hearing before a panel from the next higher command, then the member does not have the right to demand a courts martial.
4. To add in the fine as a punishment to be consistent with the federal UCMJ and the model state code
5. Tto clarify the authority and punishment for officers and warrant officers as well as clarifying the scope of punished authorized by the TAG
6. To clarify the service member's right to counsel
7. To clarify the service member's right to appeal
