| 5 | (a) Creation. There is created an Early Retirement Study Committee to |
| 6 | study the issue of early retirement benefits for the employees described in |
| 7 | subsection (c) of this section. |
| 8 | (b) Membership. The Early Retirement Study Committee shall be |
| 9 | composed of the following nine members: |
| 10 | (1) one current member of the House of Representatives, who shall be |
