

1 Sec. X. PERU CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH; HOLDING TANK

2 Notwithstanding 10 V.S.A. § 1979(a) and (b) and relevant provisions of the  
3 Agency of Natural Resources potable water supply and wastewater system  
4 rules, the Secretary of Natural Resources shall issue a potable water supply and  
5 wastewater system permit for the Peru Congregational Church in Peru,  
6 Vermont that allows the use of a sewage pumpout and holding tank provided  
7 that:

8 (1) The Peru Congregational Church shall provide evidence of financial  
9 resources or surety sufficient to meet the operations, maintenance and repair  
10 costs of the sewage pumpout and holding tank for 15 years. Evidence of  
11 financial resources or surety may include a surety bond, letters of credit,  
12 dedicated banking accounts, or other similar financial instruments or  
13 obligations.

14 (2) If a potable water supply is not available for use for hand washing,  
15 pre-moistened towelettes or waterless hand washing gels with paper towels  
16 shall be approved as the hand washing facilities.

17 (3) The Peru Congregational Church shall submit a signed agreement  
18 with a septic service that specifies a method and expected frequency of  
19 pumping of the sewage pumpout and holding tank sufficient to meet a design  
20 flow for use by 90 people per week.

1           (4) The permit issued under this section shall require compliance with  
2           the requirements of 10 V.S.A. § 1979(c) for the design, maintenance, and  
3           operation of the sewage pumpout and holding tank.
