5 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the  
6 charge of the Vermont Child Poverty Council to authorize specifically the  
7 Council to meet during the legislative session.

8 An act relating to the charge of the Vermont Child Poverty Council

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

10 Sec. 1. 2007 Acts and Resolves No. 68, Sec. 1 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 1. VERMONT CHILD POVERTY COUNCIL

13 (b)(1) The ~~council~~ Council shall consist of the following members or their  
14 designees:

16 (3) The ~~council~~ Council shall meet up to six times while the ~~general~~  
17 ~~assembly~~ General Assembly is not in session to perform its functions under  
18 this section. For participation in meetings during the legislative interim,  
19 Council members shall be entitled to compensation or compensation and  
20 reimbursement for expenses pursuant to subsection (e) of this section. The

1 Council may meet an unlimited number of times during the legislative session,  
2 but Council members shall not receive compensation or compensation and  
3 reimbursement for expenses pursuant to subsection (e) of this section for  
4 participation in meetings. In addition, during the 2007 legislative interim, the  
5 ~~council~~ Council shall hold 14 public hearings as required under subsection (d)  
6 of this section.

8 (e) Funds from private and public sources may be accepted and utilized by  
9 the ~~council~~ Council to develop and implement the plan and provisions of this  
10 section. Legislative members of the ~~committee~~ Council shall be entitled to  
11 compensation and reimbursement for expenses under ~~section 406 of Title 2~~  
12 2 V.S.A. § 406. All other members not receiving compensation for service on  
13 the ~~committee~~ Council from another source are entitled to compensation under  
14 ~~section 1010 of Title 32~~ 32 V.S.A. § 1010.
