

Act No. 3 (H.17). Public records; Executive Branch; Administrative Procedure Act

An act relating to identification and notification of Public Records Act exemptions in administrative rules

This act:

- (1) requires an agency filing a proposed rule to identify in the cover sheet included in the filing whether the rule contains a Public Records Act exemption;
- (2) requires that the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules send a copy of a final rule proposal to the House and Senate Committees on Government Operations if the agency identifies a Public Records Act exemption in the proposal;
- (3) authorizes the House and Senate Committees on Government Operations to convene for the purpose of considering a recommended course of action for the Legislative Committee on Administrative Rules with respect to a Public Records Act exemption contained in a rule; and
- (4) specifies consequences for an agency's failure to identify a new or broadened Public Records Act exemption in its cover sheet on and after the effective date of this act.
