

Act No. 35 (S.72). Labor; grievance procedures; binding arbitration

An act relating to binding arbitration for State employees

This act amends the State Employees Labor Relations Act to permit the State and the employee organization representing a bargaining unit of State employees to bargain collectively to utilize binding arbitration or an appeal to the Vermont Labor Relations Board, or both, as the final step of a grievance procedure. This act also creates a procedure for an appeal from an arbitration decision, and makes technical and conforming changes to the State Employees Labor Relations Act.
