

Act No. 62 (H.105). Crimes and criminal procedures; public safety

An act relating to disclosure of sexually explicit images without consent, charging fees for removing booking photographs from the Internet, and expanding the scope of practice of Level II certified law enforcement officers

This act creates criminal sanctions and civil remedies for knowingly disclosing a visual image of an identifiable person who is nude or who is engaged in sexual conduct, without his or her consent, with the intent to harm, harass, intimidate, threaten, or coerce the person depicted. The act also prohibits a website from charging a fee for the removal of such images or for the removal of booking photographs (mug shots). Finally, the act amends 2014 Acts and Resolves No. 141 to expand the scope of practice for Level II certified law enforcement officers.
