

Act No. 2 (H.7). Public safety; law enforcement officers; certification

An act relating to miscellaneous amendments to laws regarding law enforcement officer certification

This act makes amendments regarding the certification of several different types of law enforcement officers in light of the new levels of certification set forth in 2014 Acts and Resolves No. 141.

Secs. 1 and 2 of the act specify that Capitol Police officers must be Level III certified. Sec. 3 eliminates an outdated reference to the certification of sheriffs. Sec. 4 amends a village charter so that it references the new law enforcement officer certification levels, and Secs. 5 and 6 do the same in regard to the certification of law enforcement officers employed as investigators by the Department of Health.

Multiple effective dates, beginning on March 12, 2015
