6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require health
7	insurance coverage for hearing aids and to direct the Green Mountain Care
8	Board to consider including coverage for hearing aids as part of Green
9	Mountain Care.
10	An act relating to health insurance coverage for hearing aids
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 8 V.S.A. chapter 107, subchapter 15 is added to read:
13	Subchapter 15. Hearing Aids
14	§ 41001. COVERAGE FOR HEARING AIDS
15	(a) A health insurance plan shall provide coverage for the professional
16	services associated with the practice of fitting, dispensing, servicing, or selling
17	hearing aids or a combination thereof for all enrollees for whom a hearing aid
18	is determined by the individual's treating audiologist or hearing aid dispenser
19	to be audiologically appropriate.

1	(b)(1) The plan shall provide coverage for a hearing aid for each ear for
2	which the audiologist or hearing aid dispenser determines amplification to be
3	audiologically appropriate, as well as all related services necessary to assess,
4	select, and fit the hearing aid, with a maximum for the hearing aid and related
5	services of no less than \$1,500.00 per ear every 60 months.
6	(2) An insured may choose a hearing aid priced higher than the plan
7	coverage and pay the difference in cost.
8	(c) The benefits included in this section shall not be subject to any greater
9	deductible or cost-sharing requirement than that which would apply to any
10	other benefits provided by the health insurance plan.
11	(d) As used in this subchapter:
12	(1) "Audiologist" means a person licensed to practice audiology
13	pursuant to 26 V.S.A. chapter 87.
14	(2) "Health insurance plan" means any health insurance policy or health
15	benefit plan offered by a health insurer, as defined in 18 V.S.A. § 9402, that is
16	licensed to do business in Vermont but does not include policies or plans
17	providing coverage for specified diseases or other limited benefit coverage.
18	(3) "Hearing aid" means an amplifying device or other hearing
19	instrument to be worn by a hearing-impaired person to improve hearing,
20	including any accessories specifically used in connection with such a device,

but excluding theater or auditorium wide-area listening devices, telephone

1	amplifiers, or other devices designed to replace a hearing aid for restricted
2	situations.
3	(4) "Hearing aid dispenser" means a person licensed to dispense hearing
4	aids pursuant to 26 V.S.A. chapter 67.
5	(5) "Practice of fitting, dispensing, servicing, or selling hearing
6	instruments" means the measurement of human hearing with an audiometer
7	calibrated to the current American National Standard Institute standards for the
8	purpose of making selections, recommendations, adoptions, services, or sales
9	of hearing aids and includes the making of earmolds as part of the hearing aid.

15	Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATES
16	(a) Sec. 1 shall take effect on October 1, 2015 and shall apply to all health
17	insurance plans on and after October 1, 2015 on such date as a health insurer
18	offers, issues, or renews the health insurance plan, but in no event later than
19	October 1, 2016.
20	(b) The remaining sections shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
