7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
8	Secretary of State to prepare separate ballots in presidential primaries for
9	military or overseas voters to enable these voters – who by federal law must
10	receive their ballots 45 days in advance of the election – to rank their choice of
11	candidates in case a candidate withdraws by the time of the election.
12 13	An act relating to requiring rank choice voting for military or overseas voters in presidential primaries
14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. 17 V.S.A. § 2704a is added to read:
16	§ 2704a. MILITARY OR OVERSEAS VOTERS; RANK CHOICE
17	BALLOTS
18	(a)(1) The Secretary of State shall prepare and distribute for each
19	presidential primary a separate early voter absentee rank choice ballot for each

1	qualified military or overseas voter, which shall be labeled "EARLY VOTER
2	ABSENTEE RANK CHOICE BALLOT."
3	(2) The rank choice ballot shall conform to the standard presidential
4	primary ballot but shall permit the military or overseas voter to vote his or her
5	order of preference for each candidate by indicating a rank next to the
6	candidate's name on the ballot, with "1" being the highest rank and indicating
7	the voter's most preferred candidate.
8	(3) The rank choice ballot shall include instructions explaining the rank
9	choice voting process.
10	(b) For any presidential primary, a town clerk shall send an early voter
11	absentee rank choice ballot to each qualified military or overseas voter in
12	accordance with subsection 2539(c) of this title.
13	(c) The voter shall not be required to indicate a preference for more than
14	one candidate on the ballot.

18	(g) When votes are being tallied, a vote on an early voter absentee rank
19	choice ballot in a presidential primary shall be counted as one vote for the
