2	commercial building that contains four or more residential units as of the
3	effective date of this act.
4	(3) "Residential building" means a residential building as defined under
5	section 51 of this subchapter.
6	(4) "Residential unit" means a separately enclosed space within a
7	building that meets or is intended to meet the living needs of one or more
8	individuals.
9	(b) Building energy standards for existing apartment buildings. On or
10	before July 1, 2016, an existing apartment building that contains one or more
11	residential units for which the landlord requires a tenant to pay heating costs as
12	of the effective date of this section shall comply with the applicable building
13	energy standards adopted under this subchapter. For an existing apartment
14	building containing one or more residential units for which the landlord
15	requires a tenant to pay heating costs at a time subsequent to the effective date
16	of this section, the building shall comply with the applicable building energy
17	standards adopted under this subchapter that are in effect at the time the
18	landlord begins requiring the payment of those heating costs.
19	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
20	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
