7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to define what is
8	a slow-moving vehicle, and what constitutes impeding other traffic, for
9	purposes of an existing law requiring slow-moving vehicles that impede other
10	traffic to pull off the highway at the first opportunity.

12	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
13	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1082 is amended to read:
14	§ 1082. SLOW-MOVING VEHICLES
15	(a) As used in this section:
16	(1) "Slow-moving vehicle" means a vehicle that is proceeding at a rate
17	of speed less than the normal flow of traffic at the particular time and place,
18	but does not include a vehicle proceeding at or above the applicable speed
19	<u>limit.</u>

1	(2) "Vehicle that impedes other traffic on a highway" means a
2	slow-moving vehicle behind which five or more vehicles are formed in a line.
3	(b) All slow-moving vehicles shall keep at all times as close to the
4	right-hand side of the highway as is reasonably practicable.
5	(c) A person operating a motor vehicle which that impedes other traffic or
6	a highway shall pull off the highway at the first opportunity when it is lawful
7	to do so in order to allow the traffic to pass before proceeding.
8	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
9	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
