6	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize the
7	legislative body of a municipality to restrict and regulate cut-through traffic or
8	class 3 and 4 town highways located entirely within the municipality.

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1008 is amended to read:
13	§ 1008. REGULATIONS IN MUNICIPALITIES
14	* * *
15	(c)(1) As used in this subsection, "cut-through traffic" means vehicular
16	traffic passing through an area without having an origin or destination within
17	the area.
18	(2) The legislative body of a municipality may make special regulations
19	to restrict, prohibit, or otherwise regulate cut-through traffic on class 3 and

class 4 town highways located entirely within the municipality. The legislative

1	body may authorize that barriers be erected pursuant to such regulations. Signs
2	indicating the special regulations must be conspicuously posted in and near all
3	areas affected.
4	(d) Municipal motor vehicle regulations shall not duplicate or contradict
5	any provision of this title.
5	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
7	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
