Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to remove
ferrous scrap from the statutory definition of metal article.

An act relating to clarifying items subject to the law governing scrap metal
processors

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. § 3021 is amended to read:

§ 3021. DEFINITIONS

As used in this chapter:

(1) [Repealed.]

(2) “Ferrous scrap” means any scrap metal consisting primarily of iron,
or steel, or both, including large manufactured articles such as automobile
bodies that may contain other substances to be removed and sorted during
normal processing operations of scrap metal.

(3) “Metal article” means any manufactured item consisting of metal
that is usable for its originally intended purpose without processing, repair, or

1 alteration, including railings, copper or aluminum wire, copper pipe and
2 tubing, bronze cemetery plaques, urns, markers, plumbing fixtures, and
3 cast-iron radiators; provided, however, that “metal article” does not include an
4 item that also meets the definition of “ferrous scrap” under subdivision (2) of
5 this section.
