Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require a Vermont restaurant to provide a braille version of its menu.

An act relating to requiring braille menus at Vermont restaurants

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. § 4502(m) is added to read:

(m) Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary, a place of public accommodation that offers to sell food shall make a braille version of its menu available to the public.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
