15	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal years 2017 and
16	2018 only, "excess spending" under 32 V.S.A. § 5401(12) means the
17	per equalized pupil amount of the district's education spending, as defined in
18	16 V.S.A. § 4001(6), plus any amount required to be added from a Capital
19	Construction Reserve Fund under 24 V.S.A. § 2804(b), that is in excess of the

3	(1) For districts where the total amount of exclusions in 16 V.S.A.
4	§ 4001(6)(B) either stays the same or increases from the prior fiscal year to the

6	the district's education spending, plus any amount required to be added from a
7	Capital Construction Reserve Fund under 24 V.S.A. § 2804(b) that is in excess
8	of the district's per-equalized-pupil amount of education spending in the prior
9	fiscal year, plus the district's allowable growth. As used in this subdivision,
10	"education spending" means education spending as defined in 16 V.S.A.
11	§ 4001(6) after the exclusions in 16 V.S.A. § 4001(6)(B) are subtracted.
12	(2) For districts where the total amount of exclusions in 16 V.S.A.
13	§ 4001(6)(B) decreases from the prior fiscal year to the current fiscal year,
14	"excess spending" means the per-equalized-pupil amount of the district's
15	education spending, plus any amount required to be added from a Capital
16	Construction Reserve Fund under 24 V.S.A. § 2804(b) that is in excess of the
17	district's per-equalized-pupil amount of total education spending in the prior
18	fiscal year, plus the district's allowable growth. As used in this subdivision,
19	"education spending" means education spending as defined in 16 V.S.A.
20	§ 4001(6) before the exclusions in 16 V.S.A. § 4001(6)(B) are subtracted.
