Subject: Professions and occupations; naturopathic physicians; Board of
Naturopathic Physicians

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish the Board of Naturopathic Physicians. To do so, the bill would transform the profession of naturopathic physicians from its current status as an advisor profession to a board profession. Currently, as an advisor profession, the Secretary of State appoints two licensed naturopathic physicians to serve as advisors to the Director of the Office of Professional Regulation in matters relating to the professional regulation of naturopathic physicians. As a board profession under the Office, the Governor would appoint members to the Board of Naturopathic Physicians and the Board would be responsible for the professional regulation of naturopathic physicians.
