17	(b) Clerical and office staff in the office of the defender general Office of
18	the Defender General and in all local offices shall be hired by the defender
19	general Defender General. Clerical and office staff shall be state State
20	employees paid by the state State, and shall receive those benefits and

2	situated, unless otherwise covered by the provisions of a collective bargaining
3	agreement setting forth the terms and conditions of employment, negotiated

5	staff employed by the office of the defender general Office of the Defender
6	General shall not be part of the classified service as set forth in <u>3 V.S.A.</u>

8	(c) The deputy defender general Deputy Defender General shall be entitled
9	to compensation at an annual rate that does not exceed an amount \$500.00 less
10	than the salary of the defender general Defender General. The public
11	defenders and deputy public defenders shall be entitled to compensation at
12	annual rates not to exceed an amount \$1,000.00 less than the salary of the
13	defender general <u>Defender General</u> .
14	(d) The defender general Defender General is responsible for assuming
15	expenses for his or her office and all local offices. The entirety of expenditures
16	shall not exceed those set in the annual budget of the office of the defender
17	general Office of the Defender General and such expenditures shall be subject
18	to the provisions of section 32 V.S.A. § 702 of Title 32.
19	(e) The Defender General shall receive an early retirement allowance equal
20	to that of a State's Attorney or sheriff.
