| 10 | Sec. 1. MASSAGE THERAPIST LICENSING STUDY COMMITTEE;                        |
| 11 | REPORT  |
| 12 | (a) Creation. There is created a Massage Therapy Licensing Study            |
| 13 | Committee to examine whether massage therapists should be licensed in this  |
| 14 | State.  |
| 15 | (b) Membership. The Committee shall be composed of the following eight      |
| 16 | members:  |
| 17 | (1) the Director of the Office of Professional Regulation or                |
| 18 | designee; and   |
| 19 | (2) the following members, who shall be appointed by the Governor:          |
| 20 | (A) two massage therapists;   |

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| 2  | (C) an orthopedic physician;   |
| 3  | (D) an oncology physician;   |
| 4  | (E) a physical therapist; and  |
| 5  | (F) the director of a spa.   |
| 6  | (c) Powers and duties. The Committee shall examine and recommend                 |
| 7  | whether massage therapists should be licensed as a profession by the Office of   |
| 8  | Professional Regulation. In conducting this examination, the Committee shall     |
| 9  | consider the standards for regulating a profession set forth in 26 V.S.A. § 3105 |
| 10 | as well as the increasingly complex nature of massage therapy and how the        |
| 11 | practice currently fits into Vermont's health care delivery system.              |
| 12 | (d) Assistance. The Committee shall have the administrative, technical,          |
| 13 | and legal assistance of the Office of Professional Regulation.                   |
| 14 | (e) Report. On or before January 15, 2016, the Committee shall submit to         |
| 15 | the Senate and House Committees on Government Operations its                     |
| 16 | recommendations regarding whether massage therapists should be licensed.         |
| 17 | The report of the Committee may take the form of draft legislation.              |
| 18 | (f) Meetings.  |
| 19 | (1) The Director of the Office of Professional Regulation shall call the         |
| 20 | first meeting of the Committee, to occur on or before September 1, 2015.         |

| 1  | (2) The Committee shall select co-chairs from among its members at the       |
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| 2  | first meeting.   |
| 3  | (3) A majority of the membership shall constitute a quorum.                  |
| 4  | (4) The Committee shall cease to exist on January 15, 2016.                  |
| 5  | (g) Reimbursement. Members of the Committee who are not employees of         |
| 6  | the State of Vermont and who are not otherwise compensated or reimbursed     |
| 7  | for their attendance shall be entitled to per diem compensation and          |
| 8  | reimbursement of expenses pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1010 for no more than five |
| 9  | meetings.  |
