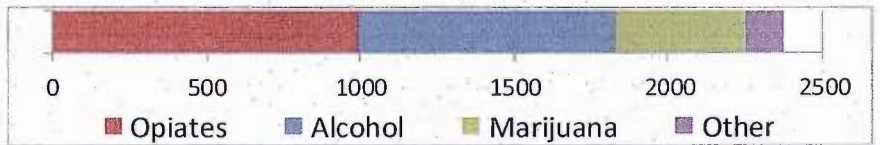

in Chittenden County for State Fiscal Year of 2013



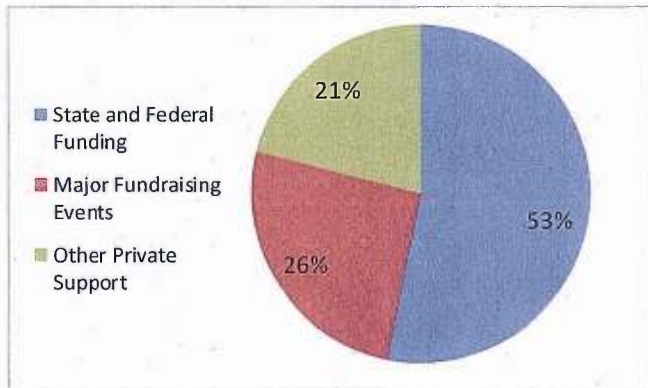

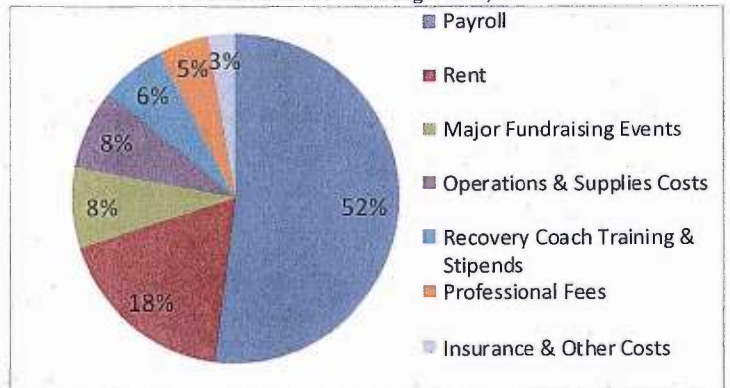
