

## Current State:

### 10 V.S.A. Chp. 55 includes:

- Subchapter on municipal loans for engineering planning
- Application to Agency for funds
- Individual sections governing municipal loans and grants for each of the following types of projects:
  - Water supply
  - CSOs
  - Dry weather sewage flows
  - Wastewater treatment facilities with capacity of 250,000 gallons or more per day
- Authority to adopt priority system

### 24 V.S.A. Chp. 120 includes:

- Lists all revolving loans funds
- Municipality may apply for loans for:
  - Publicly-owned sewage systems
  - Sewage treatment or disposal plants
  - Pollution control facilities
  - Water supply and water system projects
  - Solid Waste Handling
  - Privately-owned wastewater systems
- Based upon priority system, Agency submits project priority list to the Bond Bank
- Application to Bond Bank and loan agreements
- Bond Bank awards loans to eligible projects from appropriate revolving loan fund based upon priority list & loan application
- Loans through municipalities for privately-owned wastewater systems and potable water supplies
- Subchapter on loans to private entities for public water systems

## Proposed State:

### 10 V.S.A. Chp. 55 includes:

- Subchapter on municipal loans for engineering planning
- Application to Agency for funds
- Section for municipal loans for water supply projects
- Authority to award loans for CSOs, dry weather sewage flows, and wastewater treatment facilities consolidated in Chp. 120
- Consolidates municipal grants into one section for all “water pollution abatement and control facilities”
- Authority to adopt priority system

### 24 V.S.A. Chp. 120 includes:

- Lists all revolving loans funds
- Municipality may apply for loans for:
  - “Water pollution abatement and control facilities;” covers all previous authorities and expands authorities to allow loans to municipalities for a wider array of projects consistent with the purposes of Act 64 & the Lake Champlain TMDL
  - Water supply and water system projects
  - Solid Waste Handling
  - Privately-owned wastewater systems
- Based upon priority system, Agency submits project priority list to the Bond Bank
- Application to Bond Bank and loan agreements
- Bond Bank awards loans to eligible projects from appropriate revolving loan fund based upon priority list & loan application
- Loans through municipalities for privately-owned wastewater systems and potable water supplies
- Subchapter on loans to private entities for public water systems
- Provision requiring Agency report on loans to private entities
