Representative Chesnut-Tangerman of Middletown Springs moves that the bill be amended as follows:

First: In Sec. 1, in 26 V.S.A. § 910, by striking out the repeal of subdivision (6) and by amending subdivision (6) to read:

(6) Any electrical work in a building used for dwelling or residential purposes ~~which~~ that contains no more than two dwelling units, provided:

(A)(i) a licensed master electrician, the Commissioner, a municipal inspector, or an electrical inspector inspects the work for safety and compliance with any applicable electrical code or standard adopted by the Board; and

(ii) the person who performs the inspection provides the owner of the building with a written certification of inspection; or

(B) the work is of a type specified by rule of the Board that a person may perform without a license.
