15	(7)(A)(i) That the name of any grievant who the Board exonerates of
16	misconduct for which he or she was disciplined shall be redacted from the
17	version of the Board's decision that is posted on the Board's website.
18	(ii) Nothing in this subdivision (7)(A) shall be construed to require
19	the Board to redact the name of the grievant from any other version of the
20	Board's decision or from any other documents related to the grievance.

1	(B) Nothing in this subdivision (7) shall be construed to modify an
2	individual's right to privacy pursuant to any law, rule, or policy.
3	Sec. 2. GRIEVANT PREVIOUSLY EXONERATED; REDACTION OF
4	NAME FROM BOARD DECISION
5	(a) On or before January 1, 2017, the Vermont Labor Relations Board shall
6	adopt rules necessary to permit a grievant who, in a decision issued after
7	December 31, 1994, the Board exonerated of misconduct for which he or she
8	was disciplined to petition the Board to redact his or her name from the version
9	of the Board's decision that is posted on the Board's website.
10	(b)(1) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require the Board to
11	redact the name of the grievant from any other version of the Board's decision
12	or from any other documents related to the grievance.
13	(2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to modify an individual's
14	right to privacy pursuant to any law, rule, or policy.
15	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
16	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
