16	(a) An application for, or renewal of, a motor vehicle driver's license shall					
17	serve as a simultaneous application to register to vote unless the applicant					
18	declines to sign the voter registration portion of the application checks the box					
19	on the application designating that he or she declines to use the application as a					

1	(b)(1) The voter registration portion of the motor vehicle driver's license					
2	application shall provide and request the following information: required to be					
3	provided under section 2145 of this title and shall be in the form approved by					
4	the Secretary of State.					
5	(A) The applicant's citizenship.					
6	(B) The applicant's age.					
7	(C) The applicant's place and date of birth.					
8	(D) The applicant's town of legal residence.					
9	(E) The applicant's street address or a description of the physical					
10	location of the applicant's residence. The description must contain sufficient					
11	information so that the town clerk can determine whether the applicant is a					
12	resident of the town.					
13	(F) The voter's oath and a space for a person administering the					
14	voter's oath to another to execute the written notification required by section					
15	2124 of this title. The oath shall be preceded by the following statement					
16	"Every voter must take the voter's oath before voting for the first time in					
17	Vermont. You can attest for yourself that you have taken the oath or you can					
18	have any person over 18 attest that you have taken the oath."					
19	(G) The applicant's e-mail address, which shall be optional to					
20	provide.					

1	(2) The motor vehicle driver's license application shall provide the					
2	following statements:					
3	(A) "By signing and submitting this application you are authorizing					
4	the Department of Motor Vehicles to transmit this application to the Secretary					
5	of State for voter registration purposes. The office through which you					
6	submitted this application will remain confidential and will be used only for					
7	voter registration purposes."					
8	(B) "YOU MAY DECLINE TO REGISTER. If you decline to					
9	register, your failure to register will remain confidential and will be used only					
10	for voter registration purposes."					
11	(C) "Keep this receipt and take it to the polls when you go to vote.					
12	This is proof you submitted an application before the deadline for registration.

14	(d)(1) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall transmit voter registration					
15	motor vehicle driver's license applications received under this section to the					
16	Secretary of State not later than five days after the date the application was					
17	accepted by the Department, or before the close of the checklist for a primary					
18	or general election, whichever is sooner.					
19	(2) The Department of Motor Vehicles shall not transmit motor vehicle					
20	driver's license applications when the applicant has designated that he or she					
21	declines to be registered.

14	(B) "If you are submitting this application in connection with a motor					
15	vehicle driver's license application, or renewal, or through a voter registration					
16	agency, the office through which you submitted this application will remain					
17	confidential and will be used only for voter registration purposes."					
18	(5) The following statement on applications provided by the Department					
19	of Motor Vehicles: "Keep this receipt and take it to the polls when you go to
