5 Barre City, and Woodward of Johnson move that the bill be amended as
6 follows:

7 First: In Sec. 5, 18 V.S.A. § 9382, in subsection (a), in subdivision (13),
8 following the semicolon, by striking out the word “and”, in subdivision (14),
9 preceding the period, by adding a semicolon and the word and, and by adding a
10 new subdivision before the period to be subdivision (15) to read as follows:

11 (15) the ACO has in place a financial guarantee sufficient to cover its
12 potential losses

13 Second: In Sec. 5, 18 V.S.A. § 9382, in subsection (b), in subdivision
14 (1)(H), following “population health outcomes,” by inserting reward healthy
15 lifestyle choices,

16 Third: In Sec. 5, 18 V.S.A. § 9382, in subdivision (b)(1), in subdivision
17 (K), following the semicolon, by striking out the word “and”, in subdivision
18 (L), preceding the period, by adding a semicolon and the word and, and by
19 adding a new subdivision before the period to be subdivision (M) to read as
20 follows:

1 (M) the extent to which the ACO makes its costs transparent and easy
2 to understand so that patients are aware of the costs of the health care services
3 they receive
