6	enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8	§ 3085b. COMMISSION ON ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE AND RELATED		
9	DISORDERS		
10	(a) The Commission on Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders is		
11	created.		
12	(b) The Commission shall be composed of $\frac{17}{20}$ members: the		
13	Commissioner Commissioners of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living		
14	and of Health or a designee designees, one Senator chosen by the Committee		
15	on Committees of the Senate, one Representative chosen by the Speaker of the		
16	House, and 14 16 members appointed by the Governor. The members		
17	appointed by the Governor shall represent the following groups and		
18	organizations: physicians, social workers, nursing home managers, the clergy,		
19	adult day center providers, the business community, registered nurses,		
20	residential care home operators, family care providers, the home health agency		
21	the legal profession, mental health service providers, the area agencies on		

1	aging, University of Vermont's Center on Aging, the Support and Services at		
2	Home (SASH) program, and the Alzheimer's Association. The members		
3	appointed by the Governor shall represent, to the degree possible, the five		
4	regions of the State.		
5	(c) Members appointed by the Governor shall be appointed for terms of		
6	three years and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor. A member		
7	appointed to fill a vacancy occurring other than by expiration of a term shall be		
8	appointed only for the unexpired portion of the term.		
9	(d) Legislative members shall be entitled to compensation and expenses as		
10	provided in 2 V.S.A. § 406 for no more than six meetings per year; the		
11	remaining members shall be entitled to compensation and expenses as		
12	provided in 32 V.S.A. § 1010 for no more than six meetings per year. Payment		
13	to legislative members shall be from the appropriation to the Legislature.		
14	Payment to the remaining members shall be from the appropriation to the		
15	Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent Living.		
16	* * *		
17	(h) Annually, on or before January 15, the Commission shall submit a		
18	written report to the House Committee on Human Services and to the Senate		
19	Committee on Health and Welfare with its findings and any recommendations		
20	for legislative action.
