16	(b) Beginning in 2018, the Department of Health shall generate and make	
17	available to the public a biennial statistical report of the information collected	
18	pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, as long as releasing the information	
19	complies with the federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act	
20	of 1996, Pub. L. No. 104-191.
